- V. TB Liaisons Role i.e. Cooperative Agreement- Diane Fortune
  - Email was sent to workgroup and discussed
    - No tie to funding should be made clear
    - No link to NSET indicators
    - Should have TB Corrections Liaison identified by name for each state
      1. California could serve as example
    - Liaisons priority to work in context of state with corrections related to public health
    - Could expand role if needed in bigger cities
    - Once identified local competency to funnel through liaison
    - Local correctional liaison will need to communicate with local, county, and state level corrections
  - Diana will type up recommendation for group to review
    - Side Note—Continuity of care will be addressed in training not in recommendation

- Corrections Surveillance for Action Workgroup Update- Carla Chee
  - Working on establishing CDC Surveillance Slide set for correctional data set that can be updated every 2 years (no time line set at this time)
  - Will be looking for feedback on proposal on CDC Data-Single point in time correctional data this is being headed by Lauren Lambert
- Education and Training Workgroup – Barbara Vassell
  - Planning for Training needs assessment that will be sent out to Correctional Liaisons, modeled after past RTMCC Trainings
  - Working with Stephanie at RTMCC to work together on medical provider training
  - Florida RTMCC working on creating video of NTCA Tara Wildes presentation- Target Audience to be Correctional Staff.
  - Diana-look into possible providing education for inmates, Idea about getting a group of inmates to talk about experiences. Texas had a PEER Education series on HIV maybe could do TB as well, Barbara to discuss with Texas.
  - NTCA Education to be discussed later in meeting
  - Molly stated that the CDC link to Corrections is now OPEN
